Excavating on Public Streets, Alley, Right of Way. It shall be unlawful to dig in, or on, or into, or to make any excavation of any kind whatsoever on any street, alley or public right of way in the City of Mt. Sterling, Kentucky, which has been permanently constructed by the use of asphalt, brick, wood block, tarvia or concrete, without a permit to do so, unless it is deemed an emergency. Written application shall be made to the Street Commissioner of the City of Mt. Sterling, which application for permission to so excavate or dig into any of said highways, streets or alleys so permanently constructed shall be granted upon such terms and conditions, or refused by said Street Commissioner, as he deems best for the protection of said streets and public ways. The said excavating, digging and the reconstruction of the excavation and street shall be under the personal direction and supervision of said Street Commissioner and at the expense of the applicant.

(NOTE: If it is not an emergency, you must obtain permit **before** making excavation. In the event of an emergency, application must be filed within forty-eight (48) hours of commencement of cutting or excavating).

Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be fined in any sum not less than one hundred (\$100.00) dollars or more than five hundred (\$500.00) dollars.

In the event the Applicant requests to use any city equipment (ie: signs, blockades, etc.) during the cutting or excavating of public streets, Applicant will hold the city harmless from any costs associated with the use or responsibility in setting up or maintaining the equipment during the use of said equipment. The Applicant will reimburse the city for any repair or replacement costs if any equipment is severely

damaged or destroyed. The Applicant will hold the city harmless and indemnify the city if any property damage or injury occurs for failure to properly set up or maintain the set up of said equipment.

Applicant agrees to abide by the above ordinances and reconstruct said street under the personal direction and supervision of said Street Commissioner, and according to his specifications, otherwise being responsible and liable for any damaged that may ensue.
